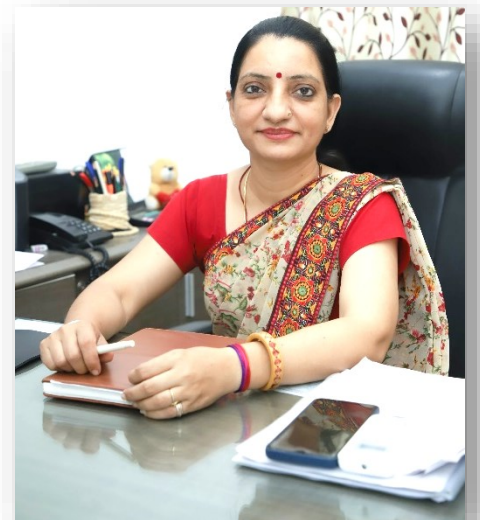
Dear Students, Teachers and Parents!

Teaching Methodology

Knowledge Imparting Mechanism (Teaching Practices & Methodologies)

- The teacher's responsibility lies in nurturing intrinsic motivation in each child.
- In the class room instead of merely marker and talk teaching, the teacher builds concepts towards an overall idea.
- The teacher also restructures the knowledge by challenging the students' current ideas.
- Our Teacher uses different teaching approaches and personalised learning styles that are appropriate for each student.
- Understand each student's strengths and challenges as well as interests.
- Provide different context for students, and use different tools and media to engage student's different senses.
- Provide students with multiple ways to access content and the curriculum.



- Provide students with multiple ways to demonstrate knowledge and skills.
- Classroom teaching is augmented by digital technological tools. The digital modules consisting of 2D and 3D animations, graphics ensures faster and accurate understanding of abstract and difficult concepts and hence improves the academic performance of students.

- Identifying learning patterns through Multiple Intelligence for primary section.
- Students explore the various facets of concepts by working in the laboratories.

Director Mr Pradeep Rathi and Principal Mrs Sonal Deora extended their best wishes to the students and teachers on this occasion.



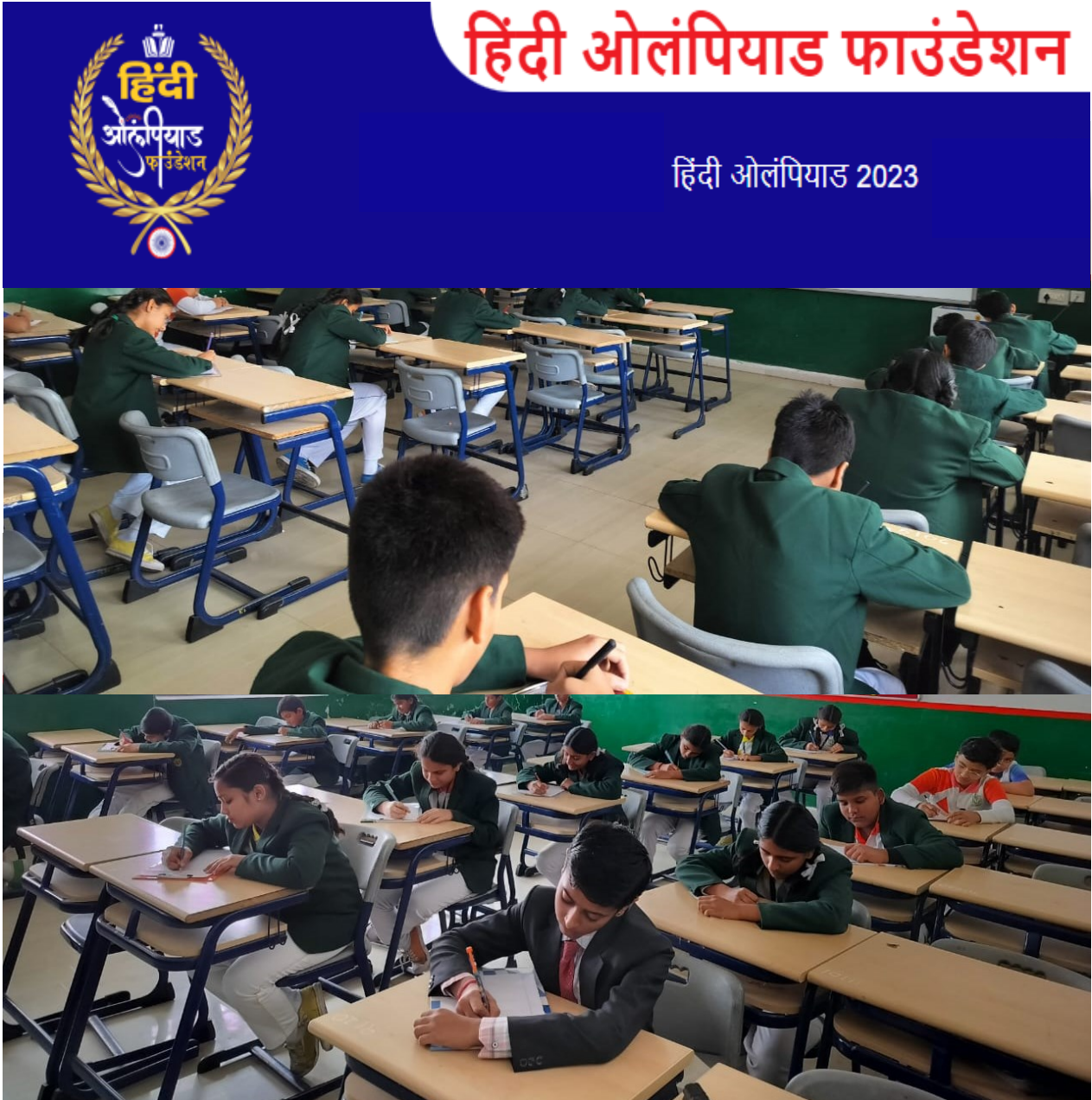


Hindi Olympiad Foundation

Beyond Academics

Sports

To instil a sense of competition, teamwork and active movement, DPS Barmer has a huge sports field and state-of-the-art amenities for basketball, cricket, football, skating, swimming, yoga, and many other games. Each sport has specialised coaches to provide the highest level of training and excellence for students, based on their talent, and sportive inclination.

A healthy sporting environment also helps students prepare for the rest of their life, after their formal education. More so, sports also teach students the value of humility. The competitions will teach them how to accept defeat and how to start a new.

“Healthy mind in a healthy body” is the motto of the school which is followed in every step of the DPS Barmer curriculum.

The playgrounds are fully utilised by the students during their scheduled game periods. The students are always accompanied to the ground by sports teachers who teach different types of indoor and outdoor games. Keeping in mind the programs (Annual Sports Day, March past for Independence Day), the students are trained by the sports teachers from the very beginning of the academic session.

These activities are held between the houses of the school and these include games like- Kho-Kho, Basketball, Cricket, Kabaddi and many more. For primary school students motor activities are conducted such as running, jumping, walking etc.

Sports and outdoor activities nourish a child’s thinking capacity and help improve physical strength. One of the best attitudes that will be developed in joining sports teams is teamwork.





Music

The Music Department aims to kindle the enthusiasm of the musically talented and offer opportunities for all, through music.

Although we may not all be musicians, whether it's in the sound of the rain, or birds at the school premises, music is a constant of all our lives and the school believes in inculcating an appreciation for the same. It is embedded in every child's education at DPS Barmer. Kids are taught vocal techniques ranging from singing to rapping, and there are solely instrumental pieces, solo vocal pieces, and pieces that combine singing and instruments. Both vocal and instrumental, is taught by a music teacher in a music room. The instruments commonly available at the school are Guitar, Drums, Cajon, Congo's, Tabla, Piano, Flute etc. and many more.

At Delhi Public Sr. Sec. School, Barmer every child is helped to achieve their musical potential through singing and music competitions held at the school on various festive occasions. Students compose songs with the guidance of specially trained Music teacher.



Dance

Equally, Dance is the consort of music. As a performing art, kids are taught various dance forms such as Indian classical dance forms like Kathak, Bharatnatyam, Odissi, Manipur, etc,

Western dance forms, and contemporary dances like Jazz, Hip-Hop, Ballet, Bollywood, Salsa, and many others are taught by professional dance teachers. There is a separate well-equipped dance room for the practice. The rooms are spacious enough which facilitate smooth practice sessions for students and the staff to prepare for various stage events and competitions.

To celebrate occasions such as Annual Day, Sports Day and other cultural festivals students are engaged in Solo or Group dance performances.



Swimming

Swimming is one of the most eagerly awaited activities for every student at DPS Barmer School. The facility is also used to conduct district and state level swimming competitions. There are changing room [s] and separate shower areas for boys and girls, with all safety norms taken under consideration with great precision. There are separate timings for boys and girls to use the pool. The coaches are well-trained to tackle emergencies who make sure of the student's safety.

Special summer camps are held at the time of summer vacations which include training programs for students who are interested in the particular sport. Students are coached for inter-school swimming competitions as well.

The maintenance of the swimming pool at DPS Barmer is a top priority and is regularly maintained and cleaned. The water is purified using chemical sterilisation procedures to ensure a safe experience. There are multiple floats and other safety equipment present around the pool area to avoid any kind of mishaps.





Skating Rink

As DPS Barmer is known for its infrastructure and sports facilities in the region, the skating rink at the school is among the major attractions for sports-loving students.

The school hosts the biggest skating rink in the region; and is made of stone. There are well-trained coaches present at the school to teach skating, skilfully.

Skating helps in improving balance and motor coordination skills and is therefore an important skill to learn. For adolescents in particular, it helps them with speed, balance, and strengthening their growing musculoskeletal structures.

Given the benefits of the sport, DPS Barmer offers this excellent activity for students, across ages, along with coaching. Students can bring their roller skates as well. Proper safety measures are ensured by the coaches to ensure safe play.





Art and Craft

Developing creative expression

The Art and Craft department is a lively, exciting, and invigorating place. It covers a wide range of skills: poster making, painting, collage making, origami, kite making, tying & dyeing, etc.

These activities are one of the best ways for students to have fun, and discover their creative spark. Valued not only for their stress-busting, these skills also emphasize the need for teamwork. They stimulate knowledge sharing and ideas, and ultimately a feeling of a common achieved goal. The school has a dedicated Art and Craft Room to preserve the students' creative work to display. Art Exhibitions are held at the school to display creations of the students.





Science and Technology

State of the art labs

There are three large, well-equipped, and state-of-the-art laboratories dedicated to Physics, Chemistry, and Biology subjects where students are encouraged to understand concepts beyond their books, away from conventional classroom learning. The perfect blend of real-life experiences and practical learning allows students to discover answers to their curiosity and also makes them immersed in the world of science and technology.

Every year these labs are upgraded with the latest and most comprehensive range of equipment, specimens, charts, etc. DPS students can get hands-on experience of exclusive science instruments at various labs and learn how to use it themselves.

Integrating labs with learning

Students are provided with laboratory tools and record books to write about the experiments they perform in the labs.

The faculties are well trained and follow all precautionary measures at the lab to ensure the proper safety of the students. These labs pique the interest of students to apply the theoretical concepts learned in the classrooms, into practical experiments.

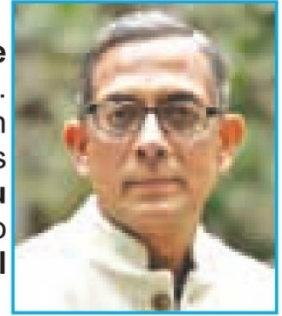

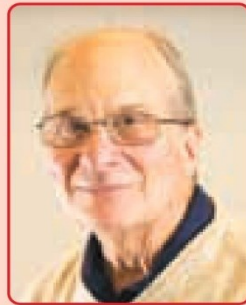
NOBEL PRIZE WINNERS – 2023

The **Nobel Prizes** are **five separate prizes**. According to **Alfred Nobel's will of 1895**, these are awarded to "those who, during the preceding year, have conferred the greatest benefit to humankind". Alfred Nobel was a **Swedish chemist, engineer and industrialist** most famously known for the invention of **dynamite**. He died in **1896**. In his will, he bequeathed (set aside) all of his '**remaining assets**' to be used to **establish five prizes**, which became known as '**Nobel Prizes**'. The **Nobel Prizes** were first awarded in **1901**. The Nobel Prizes are presented in **Stockholm, Sweden**, except for the **Peace Prize**, at the **annual Prize Award Ceremony on December 10**, the anniversary of **Alfred Nobel's death**.

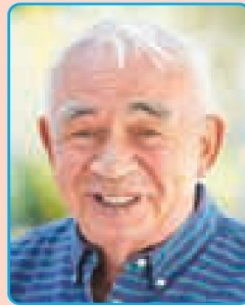
