Details of selected activities:

These activities helped the students to develop their bilateral coordination, fine motor skills, promote their artistic efforts, improve visual processing skills and promote executive functioning.

Art and Craft: "Art is the best way for children to learn."

In keeping with the theme of Creativity, Painting, Sketching, Best out of Waste. Students find ideas, activities, and crafts have a great artistic fun at summer camp. Students learn how to make cool crafts using recycled materials and much more.
