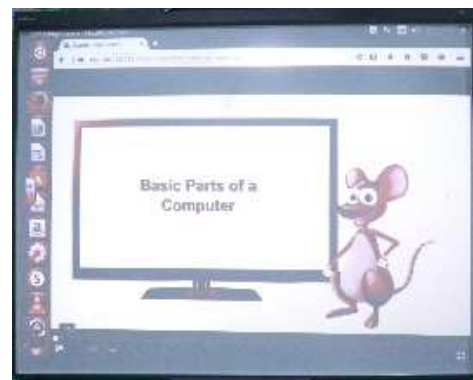
Beyond Academics

NEWS OF THE MONTH

PRESIDENT OF INDIA PRESENTS PADMA AWARDS 2024

The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu presented the Padma Awards at the Civil Investiture Ceremony-4 held at Rashtrapati Bhavan on 22nd April 2024 in the presence of the Vice President of India, Prime Minister and other public figures. The Padma Awards, one of the highest civilian honours of India, are conferred in three categories, Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri.



They are given in various disciplines such as Art, Social Work, Public Affairs, etc. In this ceremony, the President conferred 3 Padma Vibhushan, 8 Padma Bhushan and 55 Padma Shri Awards (few are yet to be given). The recipients of these awards have shown exceptional and distinguished service in their respective fields and their contributions have had a significant impact on society.

GUKESH CARVES NAME IN CHESS HISTORY AS YOUNGEST CHALLENGER

In a remarkable achievement, Indian chess prodigy Dommaraju Gukesh, aged just 17, has made history by winning the FIDE Candidates Tournament, becoming the youngest-ever challenger in the history of the World Chess Championship. Gukesh's stellar performance at the Candidates Tournament saw him score an impressive 9/14, finishing in first place.



Gukesh is also the first teenager to win the prestigious tournament. With this victory, he becomes the second Indian after the legendary Viswanathan Anand to win the coveted tournament, securing his place as the challenger for the World Chess Championship to be held later this year. Gukesh will now face the formidable Ding Liren, to determine the next world chess champion.

INDIAN GIRLS SHINE AT 13TH EGMO 2024

The 13th edition of the prestigious European Girls' Mathematical Olympiad (EGMO) took place in the city of Tskaltubo, Georgia, from 11th April to 17th April. Among the tough competition, the Indian contingent sealed the victory, showcasing their remarkable mathematical proficiency and securing a valuable collection of medals.



The 4-member Indian team secured a total of four medals, including two silver and two bronze, in the 13th EGMO 2024. This achievement marks the second time in India's EGMO journey (which began in 2016), where all four participants have secured medals at this prestigious competition.



INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

3rd April

Scientists in South Korea have set a new world record using the **Korea Superconducting Tokamak Advanced Research (KSTAR)** device. It is an '**artificial sun**' **nuclear fusion reactor**. During tests conducted between December 2023 and February 2024, they generated **plasma temperatures**. It raised to **100 million degrees celsius** for a duration of **48 seconds**.

8th April

NASA is gearing up for the upcoming **total solar eclipse** when the **moon's shadow will cross a vast swath of North America**. To capture this **rare celestial event**, the space agency will deploy **two of its specialised WB-57** jet planes, equipped with **state-of-the-art instruments** to track the eclipse.

15th April

In a gesture of solidarity and support, **India has donated 35 ambulances and 66 school buses to various organisations in Nepal**, maintaining infrastructure in the crucial sectors of health and education. **Indian Ambassador to Nepal, Naveen Srivastava**, officiated the handover ceremony alongside Finance Minister Barshaman Pun.

20th April

European astronomers have made a groundbreaking discovery – the largest **stellar black hole** in our **Milky Way galaxy**. Named '**BH-3**', this celestial behemoth has a remarkable mass **33 times greater than our Sun** and is located a mere **2,000 light-years away from Earth**. The existence of '**BH-3**' was uncovered by the **Gaia Space Observatory**, an innovative mission operated by the **European Space Agency (ESA)**.

22nd April

In a remarkable discovery, scientists have identified a new species of wild cat flourishing in the dense rainforests of Brazil. Dubbed the **clouded tiger cat (Leopardus pardinoides)**, this feline marvel has captivated the hearts of animal enthusiasts and conservationists alike. It sparked efforts to protect the region's rich biodiversity. Its distinctive spotted coat allows it to smoothly blend into its surroundings, a remarkable adaptation for survival.
