
Self Defence workshop organized at DPS, Barmer.

-5th Nov,2022 _ Keeping in view, the rising number of crimes against girls in the country, it is important to provide self-defence training to them in the schools to ensure their safety and security. Self-defence training is a life skill that helps girls to be more aware of their surroundings and be prepared for the unexpected at any time. In continuation with its efforts to make its learners well-equipped and armoured to face the unforeseen challenges in life that may put their safety at stake, Delhi Public Sr. Sec. School Barmer, organized a workshop on Self Defence -Raksha for the girl students of classes III and XII on 5th Nov, 2022. The school collaborated with an established training service for safety. The workshop covered avoidance, mitigation and basic bio-mechanics of self-defence that could be easily learnt by the young girls without having any prior experience in martial arts. The workshops were calibrated and steered by Mrs Gajju and the other members to coach the girls in the effective and power-packed concepts of Control- self-control and external control, Conflict Meditation skills and techniques like One hand grab, Cross hand grab, and Shoulder lock in real -life circumstances to promote the strength of body and mind to build confident individuals.



The workshop proved that gone are the days when women were meant to be helpless and dependent. The girls learnt an important lesson that with proper knowledge, determination, confidence and alertness, women can surpass any obstacle or untoward incident that may come their way.
