On Monday 18th July 2022, Delhi Public School, Barmer witnessed the enthusiastic participation of the budding cricketers of the school



Therefore, to promote this traditional art form amongst our students, an Interhouse Rangoli making competition was conducted in Delhi Public School on 21st October, 2022.
